RE: Treaty #8 Benefits Trust – 1) University Undergraduate Tuition Funding Program and 2) Scholarship Program

University Undergraduate Tuition Funding Program:

The Treaty #8 Benefits Trust is excited to announce a new **University Undergraduate Tuition Funding Program** for eligible students from the Fond du Lac First Nation. The Tuition Funding Program is intended to cover the majority or entire cost of a fall/winter undergraduate tuition and will be available on a lottery basis to on and off reserve students who are registered as full-time students at designated Canadian Universities. Eligible students must be registered full-time (at least 80% of a full normal course load) in the Fall and Winter Semesters of the 2024 / 2025 Academic Year.

Up to **\$7,500** will be awarded by lottery to **20** qualified full time university students in January 2025. The Treaty #8 Benefits Trust University Tuition Funding Program was designed for and is only available to those who are not receiving post-secondary financial assistance from the Fond du Lac First Nation.

The basic criteria for eligibility are:

- 1) Must be a registered member of the Fond du Lac First Nation
- 2) Have not or will not receive any post-secondary financial assistance from the Fond du Lac First Nation
- 3) Must be registered as a full-time undergraduate student at a designated Canadian University for the Fall and Winter Semesters of the 2024 / 2025 Academic Year

Scholarship Program:

The Treaty #8 Benefits Trust is also excited to announce another **Scholarship Program** for eligible students from the Fond du Lac First Nation. The Scholarship Program will be available on a merit basis to on and off reserve students who have maintained a high academic standing as full-time students at designated Canadian or American Universities.

A **\$2,500** Treaty #8 Benefits Trust Scholarship will be awarded by merit to **20** full time university students of high academic standing in January 2025.

The basic criteria for eligibility are:

- 1) Must be a registered member of the Fond du Lac First Nation
- 2) Must be in at least the second year of full-time studies at a designated Canadian or American University
